FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

Q: What is financial aid and why should I complete the FAFSA to apply for financial aid?

A: Financial aid are grants, loans, scholarships, and work-study that will help pay for college. If you do not complete the FAFSA, you could be missing out on millions of dollars of financial aid.

Q: What do I need to apply for financial aid?

A: A valid Social Security Number, be a U.S. Citizen, demonstrate financial need (provide income documentation – taxable or nontaxable) and have a high school diploma, GED or state recognized equivalent.

Q: When do I apply and is there a charge to complete the FAFSA?

A: The Fall/Spring Semester FAFSA Application always opens Oct. 1, but each state and college has their own financial aid deadline. Make sure you check the deadlines with the college's financial aid office. The FAFSA application is free!
